RE: QuakeTrip Seismic Utility Shutdown Device

The City of Surrey installed the first QuakeTrip seismic utility shut-down device in our municipal Museum building in August of 2013. The installation site was chosen because of the road and rail traffic in this corridor and the sensitive soils that underlay this particular area.

To ensure that there was no "false" trip situations, we wanted to test the QuakeTrip unit under problematic conditions of industrial and man-made noise. We are pleased to report that there have been no such "false" trips with the unit in this 6 month period and we are considering other municipal sites for future installations.
